

You and your garden are key spokes in the larger farming network here in New England that GCG has built. That network now includes 153 garden sites! And we are proud to report our gardens grew 59,000 pounds of fresh produce this year. Our mission has always been to make our communities more sustainable, more livable and joyous. Because really, what sparks more joy than the indescribable mystery of working in the garden?

It’s been quite a year for us at GCG. We’ve grown our reach substantially in 2024, with new garden installations that yield more fresh produce, energize hands-on learning, and bring the magic of growing food to more places than ever. Some of this year’s highlights include adding hydroponic farms at several Boston Public Schools, planting vibrant gardens at Ellis Early Learning so that even our youngest kids

learn about the magic of growing food, and installing flourishing raised beds at Teradyne’s corporate campus, where the produce grown on-site goes directly to their corporate cafeteria.

We’ve trained 26 farmers, and we are pleased to be able to offer our professional farmers a fair wage, employee ownership and point the way to a dependable and rewarding career. By expanding the local pool of trained farmers, we ensure that urban vegetable production will be successful in Massachusetts and move us all towards a more sustainable future.

The conversations we’ve had, and the connections we’ve made, show the true power of growing food as a community. Our farmers have enjoyed working with each of you, helping you grow food, and getting inspired by the future of our food system.

It’s been a year of optimism and growth for us. Thank you for your continued support as we look ahead to 2025. We are confident that it will be even more exciting as we watch our green community of Urban Gardens grow.
